





To get around easily, you can rent a car from the Cicar rental agency right at the airport, giving you full flexibility to explore the area at your own pace.


This 4-day itinerary combines adventure, relaxation, and local experiences, from world-famous theme parks and water sports to scenic excursions and tasty meals.



DAY 1:

Activity: Siam Park (9:00 – 17:00)

where to eat

1.On-Site Cafeteria: Restaurante Teleférico del Teide (Cafetería Teleférico)

- Located right next to the cable car station
- Offers sandwiches, coffee, pastries, and soups
- More of a "snack & view" option than a full restaurant
- Perfect for a short break before or after your cable car ride, while enjoying the incredible scenery

2. Parador de Las Cañadas del Teide (Hotel & Restaurant)

- Only proper restaurant for lunch or pre-booked dinner within the park
- Serves traditional Canarian dishes like goat cheese, Canarian potatoes with mojo sauce, meat, and fish
- Offers great views while dining

Hiking / Activities Options:

- Alto de Guajara A half-day challenging hike for experienced hikers
- Sendero Roques de García Most famous hike on the island, about 1.5 hours, suitable for most visitors
- Teide Cable Car Quick ascent to the volcano summit; costs ~€40, must be booked in advance. Permit required for summit access (free, must request at least one month in advance): Cable Car Info
- Minas de San José A good option to stop and look at the landscape like on Mars

Sunset Spot: Mirador de Chipeque – Perfect for watching the sunset with panoramic views of the park

NEXT STOP: TENERIFE NORTH

After exploring the sunny south of Tenerife, it's time to head north and central parts of the island. You'll start by checking out of your current accommodation and transferring to your new stay, which will serve as a base for the next few days. The north offers lush landscapes, historic towns, and charming coastal villages, with dramatic cliffs, picturesque mountain villages, beautiful beaches, and Tenerife's famous viewpoints.



DAY 5: Transfer to New Accommodation & Masca Excursion

Breakfast / Check-out: Enjoy breakfast at your current accommodation before checking out and heading to your next stay.

Morning Activity: Los Gigantes

Options:

- Visit the viewpoint for breathtaking cliffs or stop at nearby pools if you want to swim.
- Recommended: Just the viewpoint for photos and views.
 - Late Morning / Afternoon: Masca
 - Drive to the picturesque village of Masca.
 - Lunch: Restaurante El Guanche Alte Schule reservations recommended.
 - Parking can be tricky, so it's best to arrive earlier in the day.
 - Optional Stop: Icod de los Vinos
 - Visit the famous Drago Milenario (Ancient Dragon Tree).

Evening: Return to your accommodation for check-in and rest.



DAY 6: Loro Parque & Puerto de la Cruz

Morning / Afternoon Activity: Loro Parque

- Explore this world-renowned animal park with dolphins, penguins, gorillas, and more.
- Perfect for families and animal lovers.



Afternoon / Evening:

Puerto de la Cruz

- Stroll through the charming streets, enjoy local cafés, and soak up the coastal atmosphere.
- Dinner at one of the local restaurants in Puerto de la Cruz.





DAY 7: La Laguna & Playa de Las Teresitas

Visit La Laguna, Tenerife's historic town, and explore its colorful street.
