Currency: Caribbean Guilder (CG)
USD widely accepted

Electrical plugs: Uses same Type A and B plugs as the US, 110V power supply



Highlights: Famous for its vibrant Caribbean coffee culture, lively music and dance scenes including sega and tumba rhythms, and authentic Curaçaoan cuisine featuring fresh seafood and local specialties



Language: Dutch (official), Papiamento widely spoken, English & Spanish common in tourist areas



DAY 1


Welcome to Curaçao
